WWII Exhibition Hall presented by Robert David Lion Gardiner Foundation begins the story of our Navy Special Operations UDT teams (Underwater Demolition teams) formed at Fort Pierce Florida to engage in covert operations and the Normandy invasion.

VIETNAM

Vietnam Exhibition Hall presented by Forged is where President John F. Kennedy formed the Navy SEALs in 1962 recognizing the need for specialized underwater Navy operators for the Vietnam War.
